Weekly members of Silvercoast – 30 € per player

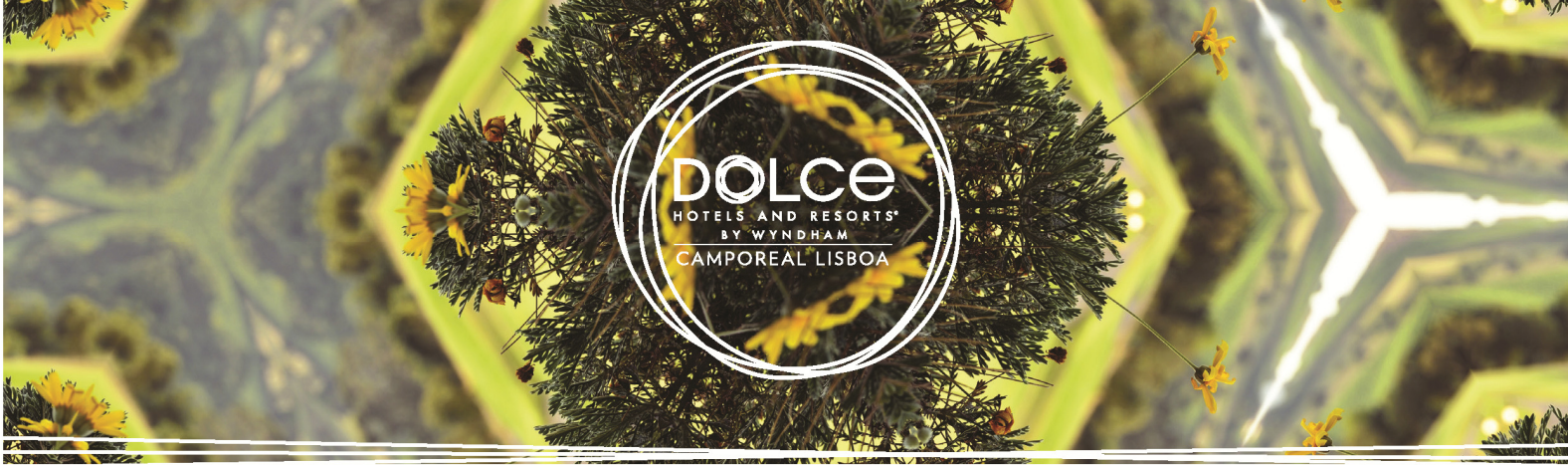
Pre-Purchased Vouchers – 30 € per player

The tournament will be played according to the regulations approved by the Technical and Handicap Commission of the Silver Coast Golf Club, Clube de Golfe do Montado and Quinta do Vale.

The rules of the Royal and Ancient Golf of St. Andrews, the Club Local Rules and the Specific Rules defined by the Technical Commission apply.





Entries can be made on the website or on the sheet affixed in the entrance of the Club-house, at least 48 hours before the date of the tournament.

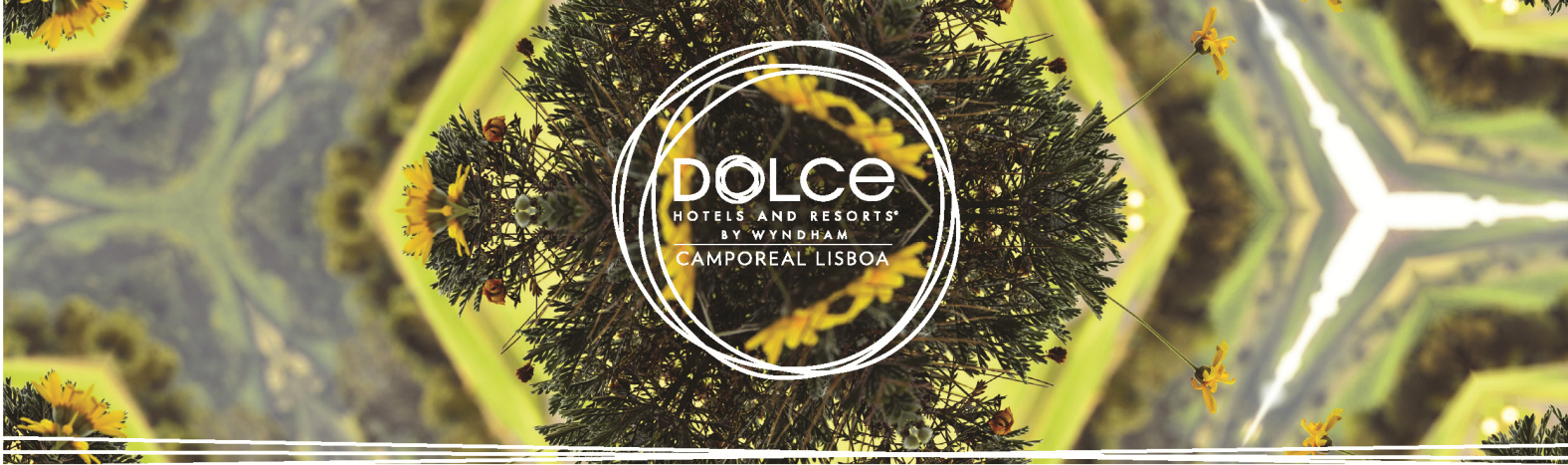
The tournament will be held through 36 holes, Stableford, Four Ball Better Ball on the first day and Full Texas Scramble on the second day (alternate shots for each pair until the finishing each hole).

On each of the days, each player Will play with $\frac{3}{4}$ of his/her handicap. On the second day, the playing handicap of each pair will be calculated through the average of the sum of the handicaps of both players, being the lowest handicap weighten in 60%.

The final result will be reached by the sum of the stableford points of the two days of the competition.

The tiebreaker will be made by successively applying the following criteria: EGA handicap lower (net) and higher (gross) through the average of the sum of the two players handicap, last 9, 6, 3 and last hole and draw.





Prizes will be awarded to the first, second and third Net results and to the the first Gross .There will be prizes for skills, and for a raffle.

Players may contest their results close to the Technical Committee within 15 minutes of their publication.

The Technical Committee of the Tournament is the Technical Commission of the Silver Coast Golf Club, Clube de Golfe do Montado and Quinta do Vale.

At any time, the Technical Committee may complement or amend these Regulations or cancel the Tournament.
