

Sporting Clay Trapper

Reports to: Outpost Manager
Department: Outpost/Outdoor Activities

Scope and General Purpose:

To provide sporting clay assistance to guests in an exceptionally safe, friendly, professional and efficient manner commensurate with the demands of a world class resort.

Essential Duties

- To ensure safety of guests and employees at all times
- To instruct guests about sporting clays rules and safety issues to ensure they have a positive experience
- To accompany guests out onto the clays course and guide them as needed on the course, 5 Stand and/or teaching areas
- To set up equipment for guests to include, guns, ammunition and safety products
- Performing trapping duties for guests to include tasks such as pulling and scoring rounds.
- To insure that equipment is put away and stored properly and that all buildings and gates are secure at the end of the day
- To stock, move and load trap machines as needed
- To liaise with other Outdoor Activity personnel to ensure exceptional activity experiences for guests
- To complete daily administrative tasks

Marginal Duties

- Assist the Outpost Manager with daily needs
- To maintain equipment and all areas of the course, store and supporting buildings
- To ensure the cleanliness and safety of the clays course, including picking up empty shells
- Other duties as assigned

Position Requirements

- Excellent customer service skills in English
- Current drivers license
- Must be able to use motorized outdoor maintenance equipment (chain saw, weed eaters, skid steer, golf cars, etc.)
- Shooting experience and knowledge of sporting clays facilities an asset
- Must be able to work a flexible schedule including weekends and holidays
- A motor vehicle and criminal records check are required for this position

Physical Requirements

Essential duties require long periods of standing and walking on trails (up and down hills) for long distances (up to 1 mile per session) as well as lifting and carrying ammunition and target cases of 50 lbs. or more. The employee must have normal vision (corrected) including close and color vision, hearing and verbal communication.

Environmental Conditions

Duties are performed primarily outdoors in the elements.
