2019 GRENACHE BLANC RODNEY'S VINEYARD Santa Barbara County



Vineyard Source

100% Rodney's Vineyard (block O2) from the Fess Parker home ranch in Santa Ynez Valley

Barrel Aging

Fermented and aged in stainless steel for 5 months; transferred to older oak and puncheons for 3 months

WINEMAKER NOTES

Grenache Blanc is a delicious full-bodied, dry white wine with fresh acidity. In the glass, it is a pale straw color with aromas of jasmine, honeydew, candied ginger and white peach. Bright and mineral driven, flavors of white nectarine, grapefruit, Meyer lemon and Key lime coat the palate.

Richly seasoned dishes are a natural fit for Grenache Blanc's refined and intricate flavor profile. Pair with ceviche, crab cakes, roasted pork with apples or Chinese chicken salad.



2018 SYRAH STAGECOACH VINEYARD Napa Valley

Aged 20 months in 100% French oak, of which 36% is new

WINEMAKER NOTES

We love working with fruit from Stagecoach Vineyard as it highlights the diverse environments Syrah can flourish in. It brings a good contrast to Santa Barbara's cooler climate Syrahs.

Napa Valley's famed Stagecoach Vineyard is known for its steep hillsides and mountain-top geography invoking intense flavorful fruit. Its high elevations combined with warm daytime temperatures and lack of ocean influence make for fruit dominated by "mountainside" characteristics, with big tannins and complex flavors.

Dominated by dark fruit flavors and black pepper with a hint of vanilla and Kirsch liqueur, this Syrah pairs beautifully with grilled meats and vegetables.



2018 REVELATION RODNEY'S VINEYARD Santa Barbara County

Aged 20 months in 100% French oak Burgundy barrels and 500L puncheons, of which 43% are new

WINEMAKER NOTES

Revelation is made from the top barrel selections of Syrah and Grenache in our effort to create the absolute best blend from Rodney's Vineyard.

Our Grenache is aged in 500L puncheon barrels which allows for less oxygen to oxidize the wine, keeping it fresh and bright while slowing the aging process. Syrah contributes darker fruit flavors and structure while Grenache brightens the blend and adds red fruit characteristics. Structure and acidity make this a wine you can age.

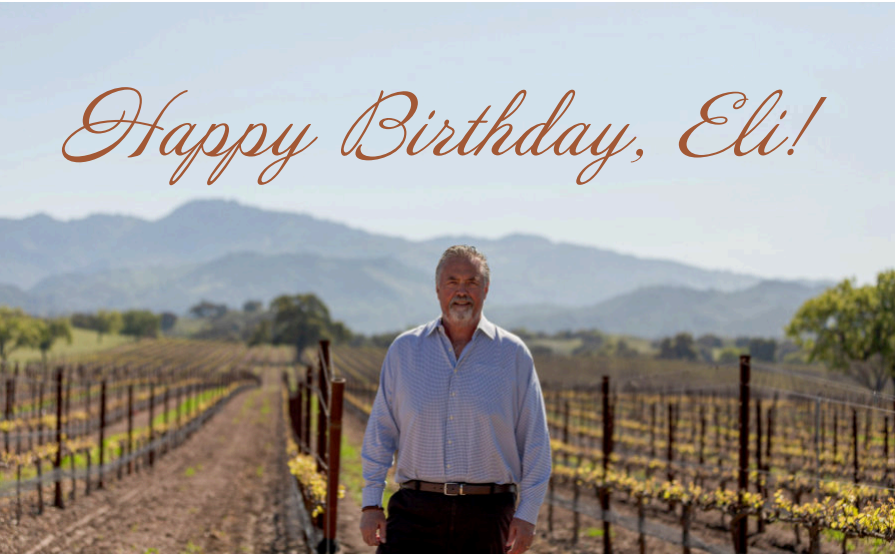
Pairing Revelation with grilled meats is a given but enjoying it with slow cooked roasts of pork or lamb is equally delicious.
