Santa Barbara County has been selected as the Wine Region of the Year by Wine Enthusiast. This is truly an honor and a tribute to Santa Barbara's exceptional wines, diverse region and talented winemakers. Congratulations to all our fellow vintners!

HEAD WINEMAKER

he 2021 vintage reminded me of 2018 with warm day temperatures and beautifully cool nights. There was plenty of early morning fog keeping the grapes cool and protected, drawing the harvesting window out well into November for the late ripening Rhone varietals like Mourvèdre, Grenache and Petite Sirah. It was another cool, ideal Pinot Noir vintage where Mother Nature didn't push my hand with quick harvesting decisions. Pinot Noir slowly came into the winery, starting in early September from the Sta. Rita Hills and was finished being harvested in four weeks. This gave us plenty of time to basket-press all of the Pinot as we prepared to bring in the first Syrah in early October. Over all, it was a very cool, long vintage that resulted in less-ripe, fresh wines with good acidity and lower alcohols. With very little winter rain last year, we are excited to see some mid-December rains coming and bringing adequate amounts of rainfall. We are desperate to fill up our reservoirs and groundwater, while leaching salts and toxins from the soils. Fingers crossed the rains keep coming!

In the winery, we finished barreling down the 2021 wines and cleaned the winery from top to bottom. Riesling and the vineyard-designated Pinot Noirs were assembled for bottling while we all enjoyed a much deserved break over the holidays.
