And therefore, we take **stock of the best in hotel matters that has opened its doors in New York**. For its originality, for its quality, for its beauty ... These are our chosen ones:

Hendricks Hotel

Located a few meters from Bryant Park and Fifth Avenue, the Hendricks hotel opened in mid-2019, in the heart of Midtown. Its impressive architecture is in charge of the neo-Machino firm Nobutaka Ashihara Architect PC. While the exterior is modern and industrial, the interior is the warmest, thanks to the details that each space has, designed by designer Marcello Pozzi of Beverly Hills.



You will be surprised by its **176 eclectic rooms**, with numerous references to an urban safari with animal print, with zebra or giraffe prints in the details, mahogany wood and copper, which cross the decorative elements and reach the amenities. You have to explore its common spaces, from the lobby bar, to its rooftop. In the lobby Paloma awaits you, a fusion restaurant between Argentine, Mexican and Peruvian cuisine, conceived by the famous chef PJ Calapa. Your proposal can be enjoyed, both in the room, and on a terrace chaired by an Inca mural of the Peruvian Julio Granados. **Dishes such as red snapper aguachile, tuna toast or tacos triumph.** Another surprise awaits in its rooftop, a lively cocktail bar with views over Manhattan and with the Empire State as a backdrop.
