Duties:

- Arrives to work on time and prepared for the shift. A black golf styled shirt, tucked in, is acceptable for setting up for service.
- Is in proper uniform by 5PM pre-shift; uniform shirt is neatly pressed and individual is well groomed
- Checks bulletin board for all updates, menu and policy related
- Participates in pre-shift meetings by contributing suggestions and ideas. 5pm unless otherwise noted
- Has a thorough understanding of daily specials and nightly menu.
- Performs opening side work duties as assigned. See attached.
- All tables are detailed and ready prior to seating.
- On floor, visible, ready to assist each guest.
- Provides consistent, knowledgeable, timely and professional service
- Performs additional side work during slow periods
- Maintains service standards and proper table maintenance throughout shift until last guest departs.
- Performs closing side work as assigned.
- Checks out with closing manager before punching out and departing.

- Must have outgoing, energetic, and professional personality and appearance
- Excellent communication skills
- Minimum of 2 years fine dining experience
- Work in a team environment
- High level of integrity
- Ability to work nights, days, mornings, holidays, and weekends
- Self-motivated and strong organizational skills
- Ability to work in darker environment if needed
- Ability to lift and carry trays weighing up to 25 pounds
- Ability to push, pull, lift, and carry objects weighing up to 50 pounds
- Ability to walk or be on feet for extended periods of time
