"It was tough to turn it off at the end," he admitted. "It was allowing myself to say 'yes' to everything — ice cream . . . burgers . . . all the wrong stuff."

Director Richard Shepard said at a Cinema Society screening Thursday that he appreciated Law's commitment to the role but wanted to keep him alive.

“He was drinking, like, 10 sodas a day, drinking nonalcoholic beer, which is disgusting, and he was pasty-faced [from] smoking. I was like, ‘Just please don’t have a heart attack until we are done filming.’ ”
