



Hotel Hugo NYC Opens Today, Will Loan You a Vespa During Your Stay

It didn't take [Hotel Hugo New York](#) nearly as long to open as was [expected](#) after its name change earlier this year: rather than winter 2014, the hotel **soft-launched in April**, and **today the hotel is officially saying "we're here, come on in!"**.

Located on Greenwich Street in Hudson Square, the hotel has 124 rooms with gleaming walnut headboards and lots of design features, but there are interesting amenities to be found outside too. We're not just talking about the city and river views either: **you can get your hands on a Vespa to tool around Manhattan with.**



Once you've done that and feel sufficiently Italian, **restaurant Il Principe** serves the cuisine to continue the idea that ancient Rome and modern New York have come together. We like the sound of the **indoor garden wall** that features 3,000 plants on the ground floor. All the way upstairs is **Bar Hugo, the rooftop cocktail lounge** with wraparound views of the city.

A Deluxe King Room runs at just shy of \$500 a night on a Saturday later in September. That's with free WiFi.
