- **Museum of International Folk Art**

- **Museum of Indian Arts and Culture**

The Museum of Indian Arts and Culture features exhibits of Native art and artifacts.

- **Museum of Spanish Colonial Art**

The museum preserves and perpetuates the Hispano art forms that have been produced in New Mexico and Southern Colorado since the region was colonized by Spain in 1598.
