Breakfast Chez Mamou

Start your day with breakfast at Chez Mamou, a cozy French café & bakery tucked away in downtown Santa Fe.

Shop Sena Plaza (*opens at 10:00 am*)

Wander down Palace Ave two blocks and start your shopping day at the historic Sena Plaza, a thirty-three-room hacienda built in 1868 by Major Jose Sena. Make sure to stop by Santa Maria Provisions, Goler Fine Imported Shoes, and Todos Santos Chocolates.

Shop the Santa Fe Plaza

The historic Plaza has been the heart of Santa Fe ever since it was founded in 1607. The Plaza is also the terminus of the original Santa Fe Trail, which connected New Mexico with Missouri. Historic buildings still line the streets and are filled with iconic shops that help define “Southwest Style.”
