### Horseback Riding Broken Saddle Riding Company

*26 County Rd, 59A, Cerrillos, NM 87010*

Start your day with a fabulous horseback riding trip (all levels welcome) at Broken Saddle Riding Company. You'll start off at the historic mining town of Cerrillos and ride on trails with colorful names like Devil's Canyon, Crooked Hat Canyon, Grand Central Silver Mine, and more. There are five riders per wrangler. A western experience like no other.

### Visit Cerrillos

Stroll through the historic mining town of Cerrillos, a reminder of the Old West.

### Visit Madrid

Experience the wonderful western town of Madrid, a creative community with over 40 unique galleries and shops.





### **Lunch San Marcos Café**

*3877 State Rd 14, NM-14, Santa Fe, NM 87508*

On your way back to town, stop at San Marcos Café on Highway 14 for lunch. You're in Cowboy Country now and this place has good food at good prices. Wear your cowboy hat if you have one from the ride. While you're here, make sure you check out the feed store around back. Walk around to see the feed, animals, and talk to the customers and the staff about how a ranch really works in New Mexico.

### **Shop Montecristi Custom Hat Works**

*322 McKenzie St, Santa Fe, NM 87501*

The next stop back in town is Montecristi Custom Hat Works, where you can order a hand-shaped Panama or fur felt hat to remember your trip.



### **Shop Double Take**

*320 Aztec St, Santa Fe, NM 87501*

Check out Double Take, a memorable store near the hotel, for fantastic jewelry, used cowboy boots and western wear, furniture and décor, and merchandise you won't see anywhere else. Double Take is located in the original Santa Fe Coca Cola plant, and with more than 25,000 square feet, there's a lot to explore. You can buy, or you can just look.

### **Shop Kowboyz**

*345 W Manhattan Ave, Santa Fe, NM 87501*

Head a few blocks away to shop at Kowboyz, a store with one of the largest collections of vintage, new, and used western wear for men and women.

### **Stop Hotel Santa Fe**

*1501 Paseo de Peralta, Santa Fe, NM 87501*

Drop off your things and change before heading back out to dinner.

### **Dinner Cowgirl BBQ**

*319 S Guadalupe St, Santa Fe, NM 87501*

Make your way a few blocks away to Cowgirl BBQ, a fabulous western restaurant in a one hundred year-old building in the historic Guadalupe district. The restaurant features barbecue, buffalo burgers, and other western favorites.

Check out the glittery dining room which features pictures of famous cowgirls, many of whom are inductees in the National Cowgirl Hall of Fame & Western Heritage Museum.
