DID YOU KNOW...

- John Rutledge, one of the fifty-five signers of the U.S. Constitution, built his home in 1763. Now exquisitely restored, it is one of only fifteen homes belonging to those signers to survive - and the only one to now accommodate overnight hotel guests. History records George Washington as visiting the home in 1791. An entry in his diary recalls a breakfast with Mrs. Rutledge.
- 18th & 19th century architecture features the elaborately carved Italian marble fireplaces, original plaster moldings, inlaid floors, and graceful ironwork.
