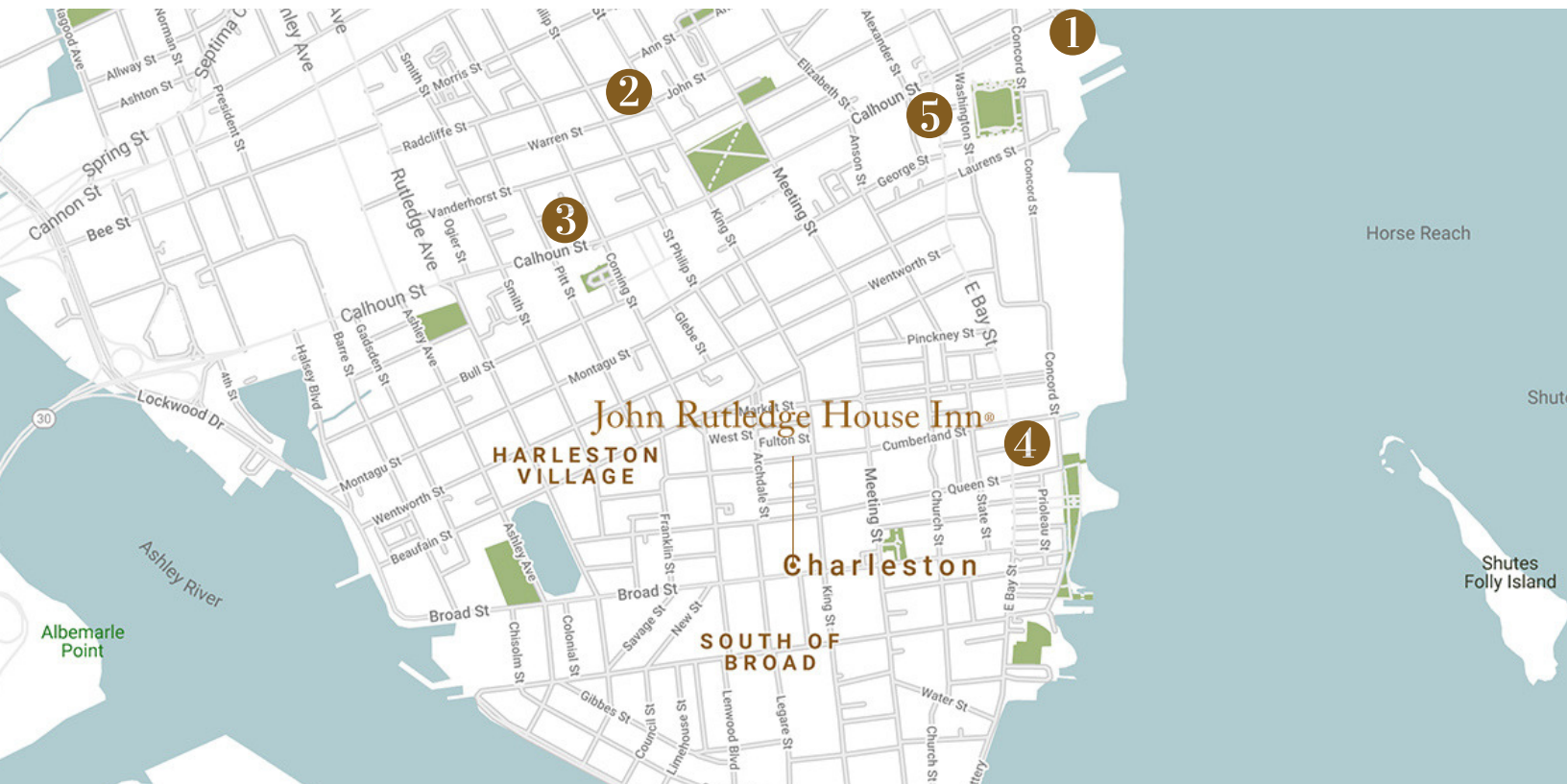


Kiddo Friendly Guide to Charleston

JOHN RUTLEDGE HOUSE INN'S TOP 5 KID FRIENDLY ATTRACTIONS



1 SOUTH CAROLINA AQUARIUM 1.3 MILES 100 AQUARIUM WHARF | SCAQUARIUM.ORG

Located on the Charleston Harbor, the South Carolina Aquarium is home of more than ten thousand plants and animals from local and national wildlife.

2 CHILDREN'S MUSEUM OF THE LOWCOUNTRY 1.1 MILES 25 ANN ST. | EXPLORECLM.ORG

This museum has nine hands-on interactive exhibits for under-10 kids including a life-size pirate ship and two-story medieval castle.

3 MACE BROWN MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY 0.8 MILES 202 CALHOUN ST. | GEOLOGY.COFC.EDU

Located on the second floor of the School of Sciences and Mathematics Building on the College of Charleston Campus. The museum displays nearly 1,000 fossils including a reconstruction of the extinct shark Megalodon.

4 WATERFRONT PARK 0.5 MILES 1 VENDUE RANGE | CHARLESTONPARKSCONSERVANCY.ORG

One of the most visited parks in Charleston, this park has walking paths and benches looking over the Charleston Harbor. During the warmer months, this park has two splash fountains that children and adults of all ages can cool off in.

5 GADSDENBORO PARK 1.2 MILES 303 CONCORD ST. | CHARLESTONPARKSCONSERVANCY.ORG

Vast public green space with sports fields and children friendly amenities with nautical-themed playground, game tables, and bocce court located near the South Carolina Aquarium.
