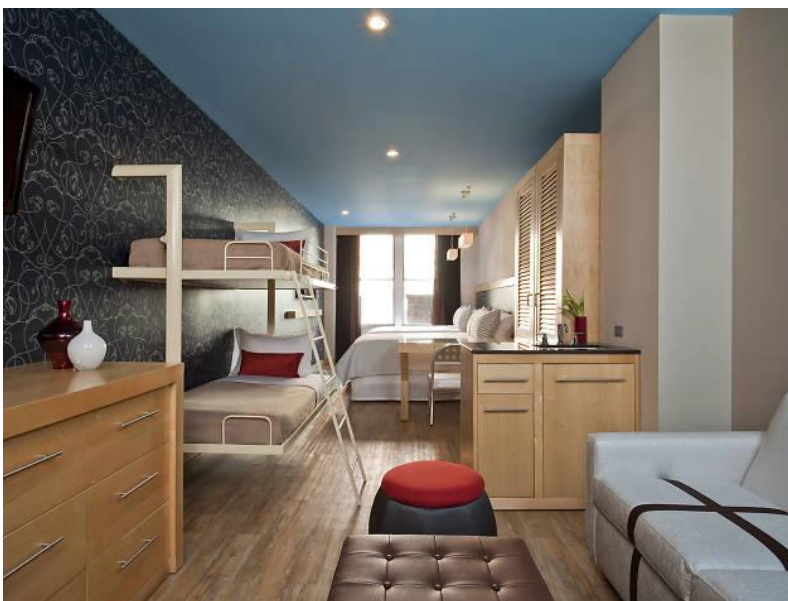

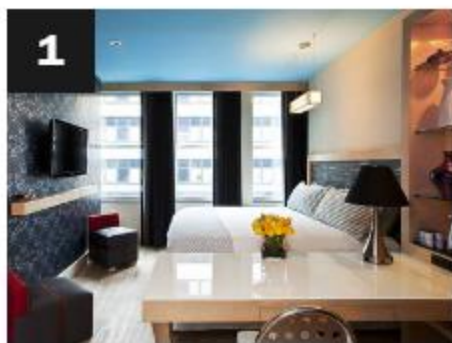
Looking for the best family-friendly hotels? NYC is the place to make your tykes feel like tiny rockstars

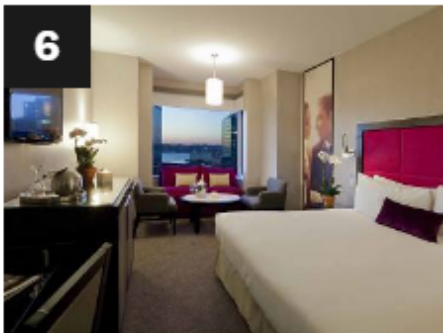
## Loews Regency Hotel New York

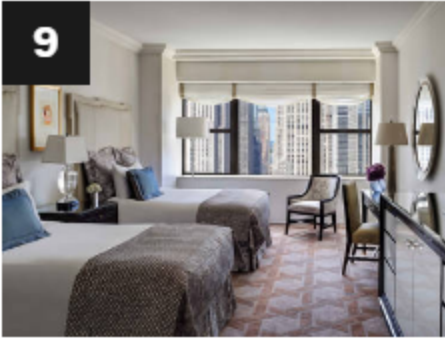
