Rainbow black and white cookie

(Dana's Bakery; danasbakery.com)
Bite into one of these \$3.50 confections and you go from black and white to blazing Technicolor — just like Dorothy in "The Wizard of Oz." The cookies are now at the Dana's Bakery shop-in-shop at the Upper East Side location of Dylan's Candy Bar (1011 Third Ave.). Not in New York? Preorder at danasbakery.com for shipping that starts the week of June 18.

Pride cupcakes

The bakery famous for bite-sized treats brightens up its Original Great cupcake flavors — cookie dough, chocolate chip pancake and red velvet are among them — with rainbow sprinkles through June 30. The Pride 25-pack (\$28) is available in stores and online at bakedbymelissa.com. Eat up — 10 percent of net proceeds go to New York's Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual & Transgender Community Center.

Big gay garden salad

It's practically ROYGBV in a bowl, served by this NYC Pride sponsor. Dig into the romaine, red cabbage, grape tomatoes, carrots, banana peppers and avocado that turn a bowl into a rainbow at just 170 calories. A

portion of the \$8.99 price goes to NYC Pride, the June 24 march to celebrate LGBTQ lives.
