



Our Hotel Openings series is a quarterly round-up of new and noteworthy debuts that are on our radar in the Americas, as well as some properties that we'll be keeping our eye on in the coming months.

Four Seasons Hotel at Nações Unidas – São Paulo, Brazil

Located amid the leafy green spaces along the Pinheiros River in southern São Paulo, the all-new 23-story Nações Unidas tower will include Brazil's first Four Seasons hotel, a 238-room property that will also boast an additional 64 private Four Seasons residences. Bold and modern, the space is built with Brazilian materials and filled with art from Burt Brinich, Francisco Brennand, and Paulo Mendes da Rocha, among others. São Paulo being Brazil's culinary hub, the signature restaurant concept, Neto, is inspired by the city's large immigrant population, offering a Brazilian spin on traditional Italian cuisine. Hotel Julian – Chicago, Illinois

Hotel Julian announces opening on North Michigan Avenue just blocks away from many of Chicago's prominent attractions – including Millennium Park, the Cultural Mile, Navy Pier, and the Riverwalk. Hotel Julian lives in the historic Atlantic Bank Building at 168 North Michigan Avenue. Each of the 218 luxe guest rooms promises stunning views of Millennium Park, the lake, and the city. Rooms include Wi-Fi, generously high ceilings, Frette linen and robes, FaBuri bath products, and other amenities. Guest rooms on the top five floors feature floor-to-ceiling customized windows. The restaurant at Hotel Julian About Last Knife is a modern take on the traditional steakhouse and features a chef-driven food and drinks menu. Hodelpa Nicolas de Ovando Hotel Imperial Club – Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic

Majestically positioned in Santo Domingo's reemerging *Zona Colonial*, Hodelpa Nicolas de Ovando Hotel, a designated UNESCO World Heritage site, debuts the new and exclusive Imperial Club, offering luxury amenities, butler service, private entrances, and exclusive accommodations.
