hot tub, beachfront cabanas and the award-winning Armonia Spa. Set above the same stretch of ocean beach as Pacifica is a second award winner, **Pueblo Bonito Sunset Beach Golf & Spa Resor**t. Opened in 2002 and the largest hotel in the company's portfolio, this family-friendly, multi-terraced resort, located 10 minutes from downtown Cabo San Lucas, features 749 beautifully appointed junior and executive suites. The hotel boasts an array of restaurants, a spectacular Sky Pool set high above the sea, and is home to The Market at Quivira, a gastronomic "food hall" that offers a wide range of themed eateries, from Asian and Italian to delicious wellness cuisine at Perfect Balance. The resort's stylish new sports bar, The After at Quivira, features superb pub fare, an oceanfront terrace and after-hours entertainment.

Conde Nast Traveler's readers also acknowledged **Pueblo Bonito Mazatlán Beach Resort**, a flagship property situated in the resort city's celebrated *Zona Dorada*, or Golden Zone. This resort, the first in the Pueblo Bonito portfolio, is an enchanting mix of Old-World charm and modern pleasures. Cilantro's Restaurant, recently treated to major makeover, enjoys a gorgeous beachfront location and has long been a premier Mazatlán destination for delicious seafood, international cuisine and craft cocktails served in an atmosphere of casual elegance. In addition, Pescados offers beachfront al fresco dining and presents innovative Asian-inspired dishes, including sushi, nigiri and sashimi.

The magazine's final honoree is **Pueblo Bonito Emerald Bay Resort & Spa in Mazatlán**.
