



ANTONIO REYNANTE VEGA, DIRECTOR OF GOLF

A native of Chihuahua, Mexico, Antonio Reynante Vega was introduced to golf by his father at the age of five and began to play in earnest at age 11 on a modest 9-hole course in Xalapa, Veracruz. A scratch golfer by the age of 18, he later competed in numerous amateur tournaments and spent two years in Temecula, Calif. (U.S.) to earn a professional golf management degree.

Antonio returned to Mexico in 2008, turned pro and played the Professional Mexican Tour, augmenting his livelihood by teaching and working independently as a golf course consultant. He worked at Club Campestre de Chihuahua and later at Malinalco Golf Club (Estado de México) where a mentor, Ricardo Paullada, who serves as an advisor to Pueblo Bonito, recommended Antonio for the director of golf position at Quivira.

The 35-year-old Reynante and his wife, Yolanda, relocated to Los Cabos in April 2015. While Antonio has been encouraged by Pueblo Bonito management to serve as a 'brand ambassador' and compete at selected mini-tour events in the southern tier of the U.S., he said he is very happy to serve as director of golf at Quivira, "the most spectacular golf course I have ever seen."
