History & Architecture

A rich and illustrious past is what makes The Culver Hotel so enchanting. Built by City Founder Mr. Harry Culver, the Renaissance Revival styled flatiron was once called the 'City's First Skyscraper', and originally had 150 apartments. From legendary ownership, including Charlie Chaplin and John Wayne, to distinguished guests such as Clark Gable and Greta Garbo, the hotel tells stories - mischievous munchkins, secret passageways, and high stake poker games are all woven into the fabric of our existence. Since the 1920's, Culver City has been at the center of motion picture and television production, in part because it was home to MGM Studios, now Sony Pictures, for many years. Hundreds of films and tv series have been shot in and around The Culver Hotel, from the Laurel and Hardy classics to some of the most recent blockbusters. As a historic landmark almost a century in the making, The Culver Hotel gracefully retains a nostalgia of days long past and remains a true icon in Los Angeles.
