JOB SUMMARY:

Responsible for providing the highest quality service to guests who are dining on the property and ensure that cleanliness and safety standards are met.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Greet guests in a friendly, positive manner and make them feel at home.
- 2. Exhibit selling techniques cum proper knowledge, and service delivery of both alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages.
- 3. Observe guest and respond to guests' dinning needs
- 4. Itemize bills correctly and secure payment as required.
- 5. Bid guests farewell by using guest's name when known and inviting them to come back.
- 6. Replace inserts, clean menu covers, and maintain professional appearance of the area.
- 7. Maintain clean environment.
- 8. Maintain high level of professionalism that will attract guests to want to return to the property.
- 9. Respond appropriately to guest needs and do so with a sense of urgency.
- 10. Clean, buss and reset tables
- 11. Monitor and replenish all items including replenishing of Beverages.
- 12. Maintain a neat, organized front-of house environment
- 13. Performs other job-related responsibilities when assigned.
- 14. Perform opening/closing tasks and side work as needed
- 15. All other duties as assigned by management

IOB QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. One-year prior food serving experience in a casual fine dining environment required
- 2. Must possess a positive service-orientated attitude
- 3. Ability to meet and exceed customer expectations
- 4. Must be available to work a flexible schedule including weekends and holidays
- 5. Must have good working knowledge of local wines and fine dining
- 6. Ability to communicate with supervisors, co-workers and guests regarding hotel matters in English
- 7. Ability to complete all necessary forms pertaining to the position
- 8. Ability to work in a fast-paced environment, as well as work independently.

- 10. Must be at least 21 years of age.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 5. Bending & Twisting constantly,

- 9. Will be required to lift up to 50 lbs.
