ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- 2. Perform troubleshooting of issues relating to hardware, operating systems and applications.
- 3. Diagnoses hardware failures and expeditiously makes repairs

- 5. Install software and perform tests on computer equipment and programs.
