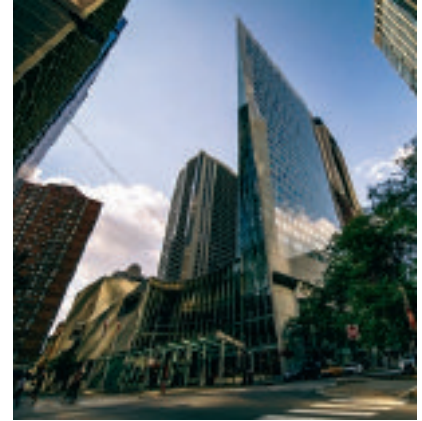

THE MOORINGS VILLAGE

SOFITEL CHICAGO

The presidential suite atop the Sofitel Chicago provides visitors with an opulent escape both in the sky and on the water. Occupying the 32nd floor, the five-room oasis boasts floor-to-ceiling windows with skyline and Lake Michigan views. CAVA SPILIADIS

Cava Spiliadis offers more than 100 wines grown on nine Greek properties. One winery, Ktima Gerovassiliou (seen here), situated on 138 acres just southwest of Thessaloniki, grows, among other varietals, a very rare and indigenous Greek grape, a Malagousia saved from extinction due to the efforts of Vangelis Gerovassiliou. The resulting white wine has the color of sunlit straw with a faint greenish cast. Its aromas bring to mind ripe pear, pineapple, lemon peel, pepper and jasmine. Malagousia has 13.5 percent alcohol and was granted a rating of 91 points by *Wine Spectator*. [cavaspiliadis.com](#)
