### BOAT EXCURSIONS:

#### BERMUDA SHIPWRECK SNORKEL

- **Cost:** \$70 Per Adult, \$50 Per Child  
**Duration:** 3 Hours  
**Operates:** Apr-Nov  
**Departs From:** Royal Naval Dockyard

### ST. George's Historical Society Museum, Printery & Garden

- Verdmont, in Smith's Parish, Bermuda is a historic house built c. 1710, now operated as a museum by the Bermuda National Trust. It is essentially structurally unchanged since it was built and it became a museum in 1956.
