

Anguilla Relaxed Entry Protocol Phases

MAY 25 – JUNE 30, 2021 | Vaccinated and Non-Vaccinated Visitor(s)



If you're vaccinated you'll only have to stay in place for 7 days.



Apply for entry approval on our website.



If you're vaccinated* you'll no longer need proof of health insurance.



Vaccinated and unvaccinated travelers must submit a test 3-5 days before the arrival date, be tested on arrival, and at the end of their stay in place.



Multi-generational families and groups with unvaccinated and vaccinated travelers will stay in place 10 or 14 days using approved short stay services only.



Groups of ten or more planning to conduct any mass gatherings like conferences or weddings, must be vaccinated to enter Anguilla.



Short-stay visitors will now be allowed to use Spa, Gym, and Cosmetology services if both parties are fully vaccinated.



PHE-approved COVID-19 Rapid Antigen cannot be used to enter Anguilla or exit stay in place.



Application fees will be \$300 for the first traveler and \$200 for each additional.

July 1, 2021 | Vaccinated Visitor(s)



If you are eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine, you must be vaccinated to enter Anguilla.



Vaccinated travelers will not be required to stay in place on arrival.



Vaccinated travelers will not be tested upon arrival.



Vaccinated travelers will no longer need to provide proof of insurance.



Vaccinated travelers will no longer need to pay entry fees.



You still must apply for entry permission.



Travelers must provide a negative COVID-19 test 3-5 days before entry.



Travelers must present proof of vaccination upon entry.



Multi-generational families or groups with individuals who are not eligible for the vaccine, will not need to stay in place. Everyone in the group will need a negative PCR test 3-5 days before arrival and may be tested on arrival and subsequently during their stay.**

*Vaccinated for the purposes of these phases refers to persons who have received their final vaccine dose at least 21 days prior to arrival.

**Tests may be subject to a fee
