## NOTICE REGARDING THE SALE AND TRANSFER OF PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION ("PII")

As the result of the sale, JD Holdings has agreed to: (i) be bound by and is responsible for complying with the Hotel's privacy policy as set forth at <u>www.jqhHotel.com/privacy-policy</u> (the "Privacy Policy") with respect to its treatment of the PII; and, (ii) be liable for any violation of the Hotel' privacy policy which occurs after it takes possession of the PII. Further, JD Holdings will not disclose, sell, or transfer your PII to any third party in a manner inconsistent with the Privacy Policy, the JD Holdings privacy policy, or applicable law.

## DO YOU HAVE A CHOICE?
