At The Spa at Wentworth Mansion®, patrons can enjoy a relaxing spa experience surrounded by 100 years of history. Originally used as the stable for the mansion, the building housing The Spa at Wentworth Mansion® was built in 1886. Before being renovated in 2005, it was the repository for unused architectural remnants from the prior renovations of the Wentworth Mansion® and the hotel's restaurant, Circa 1886. Architectural artifacts were incorporated into the design in order to preserve them and to stimulate conversation and interest in this one-of-a-kind spa.

The Spa at Wentworth Mansion® is an inviting and soothing ambiance, reminiscent of the building's history but with a modern twist. The spa features the original 14-foot-high vaulted ceilings and exposed beams, etched wood floors, glass brick and bead board woodwork. Modern lighting and other contemporary elements include calming fountains, a dual-head shower in the couples' treatment room and upscale lounging furniture.
